Lithgow Oberon Landcare Association (LOLA) is an incorporated association with local Landcare representation across the Lithgow and Oberon Local Government Areas (LGAs). Since LOLA incorporation in 1997, there has been decline in Landcare Group activity and outcomes attributable to a range of factors including but not limited to:

- changes in government funding prioritisation;
- changes in landcare responsibility and management boundaries;
- a lack of locally dedicated coordinating resourcing to facilitate community engagement and fostering of landcare activities;
- disconnection of the broader Landcare community; and
- decline in community participation within the Lithgow and Oberon LGAs.

LOLA successfully secured funding and appointed a Landcare Coordinator position within the Region to enhance coordination, focus and facilitation of community engagement. To further support the outcomes of the Landcare Coordinator, LOLA has engaged Gondwana Consulting to assist in the development of a Regional Landcare Network plan.

It is envisaged that the development of a Regional Landcare Network Plan will:

- Help identify / uncover what community individuals and volunteers understand Landcare to be currently, and want Landcare to look like in their local area both now and in the future;
- Provide a framework that will help guide strategies that increase volunteering participation rates in Landcare-based activities, by better understanding community expectations;
- Develop and outline recommendations that will assist LOLA to re-engage with Landcare Groups across the region; and
- Help develop Landcare-based priorities for the next 5 10 years which are relevant to the community.

It is important that both existing and future landcare participants, regional and state landcare stakeholders along with the wider community have input and participation in preparing the Regional Landcare Network Plan. Your input throughout the planning process will help identify what you value about local landcare, how you participate and enjoy it, perceived landcare management issues or challenges to address, and your aspirations for what local landcare may look like and what are the priorities over the next 5-10 years.
